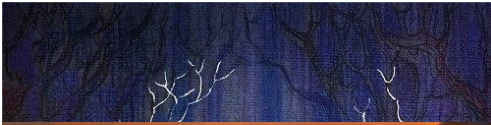


Two week self-isolation plan - Year 6

Day	<p>These tasks are warm up/ introduction tasks. You should check Dojo every day for your main English, maths and other tasks.</p>	<p>Extra tasks to be completed every day</p>
1	<p>Writing / spelling (20 mins) Write the following words out 5 times each (you could do it in different colours or time yourself in a 1 minute speedwrite): Infection, rejection, creation, celebration, position, location, question, caution, motion, direction</p> <p>English: Log onto Get Epic with your school code qxxg6077 and choose a book to read. If there is a quiz available, you should try that!</p> <p>Maths: Spend 30 minutes at least on TT Rockstars perfecting your times table knowledge.</p> <p>Story time – ask someone in your house to read you a story or check out CBBC Newsround and watch it.</p>
