- investigate numbers 0-10
- learn how to represent numbers using equipment
- identify one more and one less than a given number
- compare numbers using the phrases and symbols for less than, equal to and greater than
- Add and subtract numbers within 10

As scientists we will:

- learn about animals including humans
- learn the names of body parts
- identify our five senses
- sort animals into groups
- learn about herbivores, carnivores, and omnivores
- describe and compare animal bodies

As historians we will:

- use a variety of different sources to find out what Grace Darling did and how she became famous.
- use artefacts, pictures and videos to find out some similarities and differences between Grace's everyday life and our lives.
