In DT we will learn to:

- Design and create a battery-operated night light, using simple circuits and switches.

Our class novel this half term is Llama out loud, by Annabelle Sami.

In English we will learn to:

- Read and write free verse poems.
- We will become report writers over the duration of the term, writing a final piece linked to our Geography topic.

In RE we will learn to:

- Understand different beliefs, focusing on 'Why do Christians call Jesus the light of the world?'

In Music we will learn to:

- Celebrate a wide range of music styles linked to the theme 'What stories does music tell us about the past?' including by listening, singing, playing, composing and performing.

In Computing we will learn to:

- Use basic typing skills
- Use computer shortcuts
- Reliably know what to do if we are exposed to unpleasant materials on any device (Year 4)

We will be taking part in PE every Thursday, so children will need their PE kit.

In Maths we will learn about:

- Number and place value
- Addition and subtraction
- Multiplication and division

In PSHE we will learn about:

- What human rights are and how they protect people.
- To identify basic examples of human rights including the rights of children.
- About how they have rights and also responsibilities

In Science we will learn:

What are the names and types of human teeth?
How does the body digest food?

In Geography we will learn to:

- Locate different countries on the world map.
- We will learn about extreme weathers and the effect that it has on the individual, the country and the implications it has had on the country.
