In Computing we will learn to:

- Say how music makes us feel
- Identify that there are patterns in music
- Experiment with sound using a computer
- Use a computer to create a musical pattern
- Create digital music for a purpose

- Control different sized balls using our hands and rackets
- Move safely around a space
- Feed a ball to a partner so that they can hit it
- Hit a ball towards a target to score points

In Maths we will learn to:

- Continue to add and subtract within 20
- Count from 20 to 50
- Count by making groups of tens
- Partition numbers to 50 into tens and ones
- Estimate on a number line up to 50
- Find 1 more and 1 less within 50
- Compare lengths and heights
- Measure length using objects
- Measure length in centimeters
- Use 'heavier' and 'lighter'
- Measure and compare mass
- Compare volume
- Measure and compare capacity

In Music we will learn:

- How does music help us to understand our neighbours?
- To combine pulse, rhythm and pitch
- To explore a wide range of musical styles
- To listen, sing, play, compose and perform

In Geography we will learn:

- which continents and oceans make up our world

In RE we will ask:

- How do Christians celebrate Easter?

In Art we will learn to:

- Use a variety of techniques, e.g., weaving, finger knitting, tie-dye, sewing, wax or oil resist, applique and embroidery.
- Learn how to thread a needle.
- Create images from imagination, experience or observation.
- Use a wide variety of media including photocopied material, fabric, plastic, tissue, magazines, crepe paper etc.

- Who to tell if something upsets us online
- How and why people use the internet
- How we communicate safely on the internet
